

DSWD DROMIC Terminal Report on Typhoon “Neneng”

28 October 2022, 6PM

I. Situation Overview

On 13 October 2022, a Low-Pressure Area (LPA) entered the Philippine Area of Responsibility (PAR). It became a Tropical Depression (TD) and was named “Neneng” on the same day. On 14 October 2022, TD “Neneng” slightly intensified as it decelerated west southwestward over the Philippine Sea. On 15 October 2022, “Neneng” intensified into a Tropical Storm while it accelerated westward over the Philippine Sea east of extreme Northern Luzon. On 16 October 2022, “Neneng” became a Typhoon as it maintained its strength and exited PAR.

II. Status of Affected Areas and Population

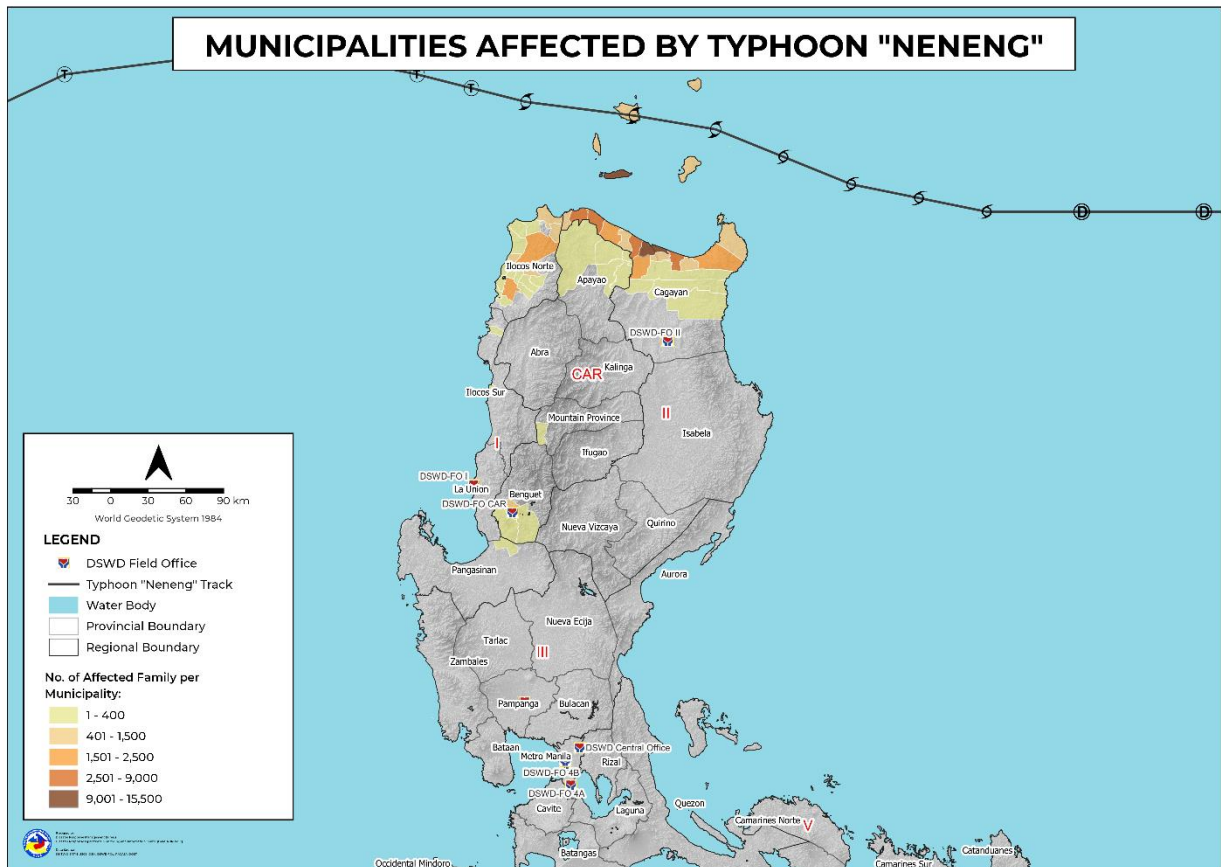
A total of **55,219 families** or **193,070 persons** were affected in **516 Barangays** in **Regions I, II, and CAR** (see Table 1).

18 October 2022	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> DSWD FO CAR through the Crisis Intervention Section (CIS) at the Social Welfare and Development Office (SWADO) in Benguet provided financial assistance to the affected families in La Trinidad, Benguet amounting to a total of ₱25,000.00; of which, ₱15,000.00 was given to three (3) families with partially damaged houses and ₱10,000.00 to one (1) family with totally damaged house.

This terminal report is based on the final reports submitted by DSWD FO CAR (19 October 2022), DSWD FO I (24 October 2022), and DSWD FO II (21 October 2022). The Disaster Response Operations Monitoring and Information Center (DROMIC) of DSWD-DRMB continues to closely coordinate with DSWD FOs for any request of Technical Assistance and Resource Augmentation (TARA).
