

## DSWD DROMIC Terminal Report on the Fire incident in Brgy. Tonsuya, Malabon City

### I. Situation Overview

On 16 October 2022 at around 1:56 AM, a fire incident occurred in Brgy. Tonsuya, Malabon City. The fire was declared out at around 6:33 AM.

#### a. Inside Evacuation Center

A total of **67 families** or **250 persons** took temporary shelter at the **Tonsuya Covered Court** in **Malabon City**. All of these families have returned home (see Table 2).
