

## DSWD DROMIC Terminal Report on the Tornado Incident in President Roxas, Capiz

08 February 2023, 6PM

### I. Situation Overview

On September 20, 2022 at around 1:30 PM, a tornado incident occurred in President Roxas, Capiz. The said incident together with the continuous heavy rain had an impact on the livelihood of the families who were fisherfolks residing in the affected barangays.

A total of **1,078 families** or **5,390 persons** were affected in **six (6) barangays** in **President Roxas, Capiz** (see Table 1).
