

## DSWD DROMIC Report #1 on the Fire Incident in Brgy. Salvacion, Bobon, Northern Samar

as of 12 November 2022, 6PM

### I. Situation Overview

On 09 October 2022 at around 12:30 AM, a fire incident occurred at Purok 2, Brgy. Salvacion, Bobon, Northern Samar. The fire was declared under control at around 4:30 AM.
