

DSWD DROMIC Report #1 on the Fire Incident in Navotas City as of 15 November 2022, 6PM

I. Situation Overview

On 14 November 2022 at around 3:58 PM, a fire incident occurred in Brgys. Bagumbayan North (BBN) and Navotas West in Navotas City. The fire was declared out at around 9:25 PM.
