

## DSWD DROMIC Report #2 on the Fire Incident in Brgy. Poblacion, Iligan City

as of 09 November 2022, 6PM

### I. Situation Overview

On 06 November 2022 at around 5:43 AM, a fire incident occurred at Zone 7, Fortaleza St., Brgy. Poblacion, Iligan City. The fire was under control and contained at 6:26 AM and declared out at 7:08 AM.
