

## DSWD DROMIC Report #2 on the Fire Incident in Navotas City as of 18 January 2023, 6PM

### I. Situation Overview

On 14 November 2022 at around 3:58 PM, a fire incident occurred in Barangays Bagumbayan North (BBN) and Navotas West in Navotas City. The fire was declared out at around 9:25 PM.
