

DSWD DROMIC Report #1 on the Armed Conflict in Brgy. Tapodoc, Aleosan, Cotabato

as of 14 December 2022, 6PM

I. Situation Overview

On 09 December 2022 at around 2PM, an armed conflict transpired at Sitio Montawak, Brgy. Tapodoc, Aleosan, Cotabato involving members of the Civilian Armed Forces Geographical Unit (CAFGU) and other armed groups.

A total of **436 families** or **2,180 persons** are affected in **Brgy. Tapodoc, Aleosan, Cotabato** (see Table 1).

- ₱277.01 million worth of other FNIs at NROC, VDRC, and DSWD FO XII warehouses.

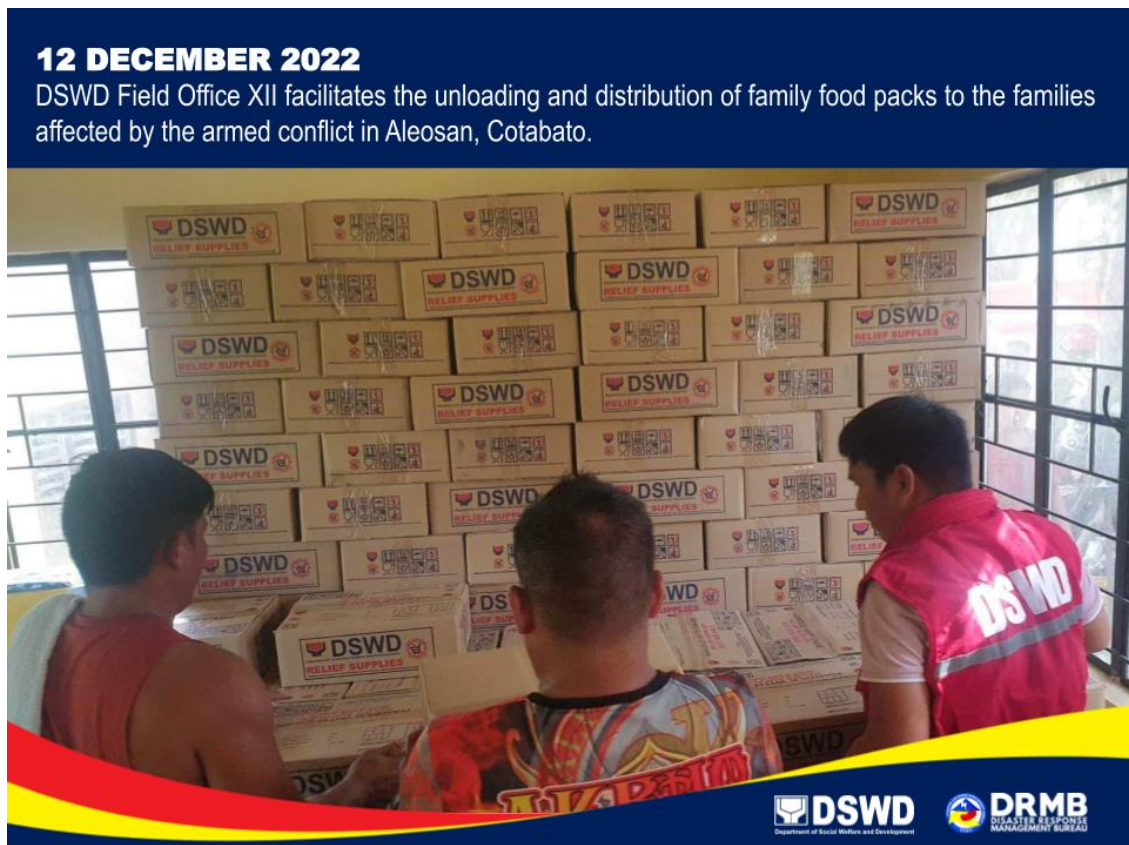
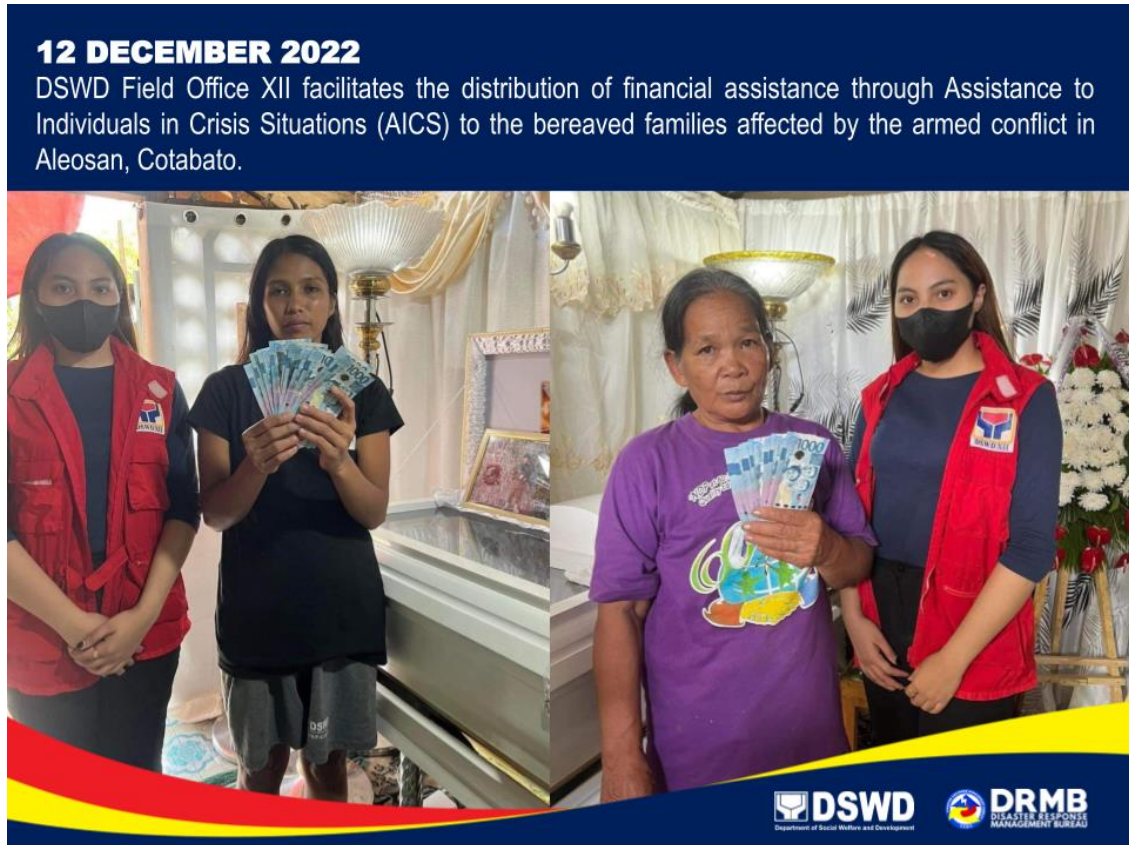
b. Food and Non-food Items (FNIs)
