

## DSWD DROMIC Report #1 on the Effects of Easterlies in Don Marcelino, Davao Occidental

as of 06 December 2022, 6PM

### I. Situation Overview

On 05 December 2022, cloudy skies with scattered rainshowers and thunderstorms brought by the Easterlies may have caused possible flash floods or landslides due to scattered light to moderate with at times heavy rains in Bicol Region, Eastern Visayas, Caraga, Davao Region, and Quezon.
