

## DSWD DROMIC Report #1 on the Fire Incident in Brgy. Leon Garcia, Davao City as of 07 December 2022, 6PM

### I. Situation Overview

On 21 November 2022 at around 10:35 AM, a fire incident occurred in Purok San Antonio, Brgy. Leon Garcia, Agdao District, Davao City. The fire was declared out at around 12:15 PM.
