1. Standby Funds

- ₱665.63 million Quick Response Fund (QRF) at the DSWD Central Office.
- ₱5 million available at DSWD FO VI.

2. Prepositioned FFPs and Other Relief Items

- 71,098 FFPs available in Disaster Response Centers; of which, 66,386 FFPs are at the National Resource Operations Center (NROC), Pasay City and 4,712 FFPs are at the Visayas Disaster Resource Center (VDRC), Mandaue City.
- 21,394 FFPs available at DSWD FO VI.
- ₱231.3 million worth of other FNIs at NROC, VDRC, and DSWD FO VI warehouses.





a. Food and Non-food Items (FNIs)

The LGU of Bacolod City provided relief assistance composed of groceries and non-food items to the affected families.
