

## DSWD DROMIC Report #1 on the Fire incident in Brgy. 59, Caloocan City as of 15 December 2022, 6PM

### I. Situation Overview

On 13 December 2022 at 12:48 PM, a fire incident occurred at 8<sup>th</sup> Avenue, Brgy. 59, Caloocan City. The fire was declared out at around 1:43 PM.
