

## DSWD DROMIC Report #1 on the Fire incident in Brgy. Holy Spirit, Quezon City as of 03 December 2022, 6PM

### I. Situation Overview

On 28 November 2022 at around 4:37 AM, a fire incident occurred at Saint Vincent Street, Brgy. Holy Spirit, Quezon City. It was declared fire out at 5:52 AM. The affected families are staying with their relatives in nearby areas.
