

## DSWD DROMIC Report #1 on the Flashflood Incident in Makilala, North Cotabato

as of 02 December 2022, 6PM

### I. Situation Overview

On 23 November 2022, the Municipality of Makilala, North Cotabato experienced flashflood due to heavy rains caused by the Intertropical Convergence Zone (ITCZ).

A total of **39 families** or **195 persons** are affected in **three (3) barangays** in **Makilala, North Cotabato** (see Table 1).
