

## DSWD DROMIC Report #1 on the Flashflood Incidents in Alamada and Libungan, North Cotabato

as of 02 December 2022, 6PM

### I. Situation Overview

On 25 November 2022, a flashflood incidents brought about by Intertropical Convergence Zone (ITCZ) occurred in Alamada and Libungan, North Cotabato.

A total of **328 families** or **1,446 persons** are affected in **Alamada** and **Libungan, North Cotabato** (see Table 1).
