



DSWD DROMIC Report #1 on the Social Disorganization in Senator Ninoy Aquino, Sultan Kudarat

as of 05 December 2022, 6PM

I. Situation Overview

On 30 November 2022 at around 9AM, a social disorganization incident transpired at Sitio Malakumo, Brgy. Kuden, Senator Ninoy Aquino, Sultan Kudarat. It was triggered by sightings of an armed group which prompted the residents and other neighboring areas to evacuate.

II. Status of Affected Areas and Population

A total of 155 families or 474 persons are affected in two (2) barangays in Senator Ninoy Aquino, Sultan Kudarat (see Table 1).

1. Standby Funds

- ₱257.9 million Quick Response Fund (QRF) at the DSWD Central Office.
- ₱5 million available at DSWD FO XII.

2. Prepositioned FFPs and Other Relief Items

- 64,997 FFPs available in Disaster Response Centers; of which, 60,285 FFPs are at the National Resource Operations Center (NROC), Pasay City and 4,712 FFPs are at the Visayas Disaster Resource Center (VDRC), Mandaue City.
- 43,711 FFPs available at DSWD FO XII.
- ₱252.11 million worth of other FNIs at NROC, VDRC, and DSWD FO XII warehouses.
