



DSWD DROMIC Report #2 on the Whirlwind Incident in Iligan City, Lanao del Norte

as of 15 December 2022, 6PM

I. Situation Overview

On 23 November 2022 at around 2:00 PM, a whirlwind incident occurred in Iligan City, Lanao del Norte which affected several barangays of the said city.

II. Status of Affected Areas and Population

A total of 49 families or 196 persons are affected in six (6) barangays in Iligan City, Lanao del Norte (see Table 1).

a. Outside Evacuation Center

- ₱70.88 million worth of other FNIs at NROC, VDRC, and DSWD FO X warehouses.






b. Food and Non-food Items
