

DSWD DROMIC Terminal Report on Tropical Storm Rosal

28 January 2022, 6PM

I. Situation Overview

On 10 December 2022, the Low Pressure Area (LPA) East of Sorsogon developed into Tropical Depression “Rosal”. On 11 December 2022, “Rosal” intensified into a Tropical Storm. On 12 December 2022, “Rosal” further weakened as it moved away from the Philippine landmass. “ROSAL” transitioned into a Post-Tropical Low on 13 December 2022.

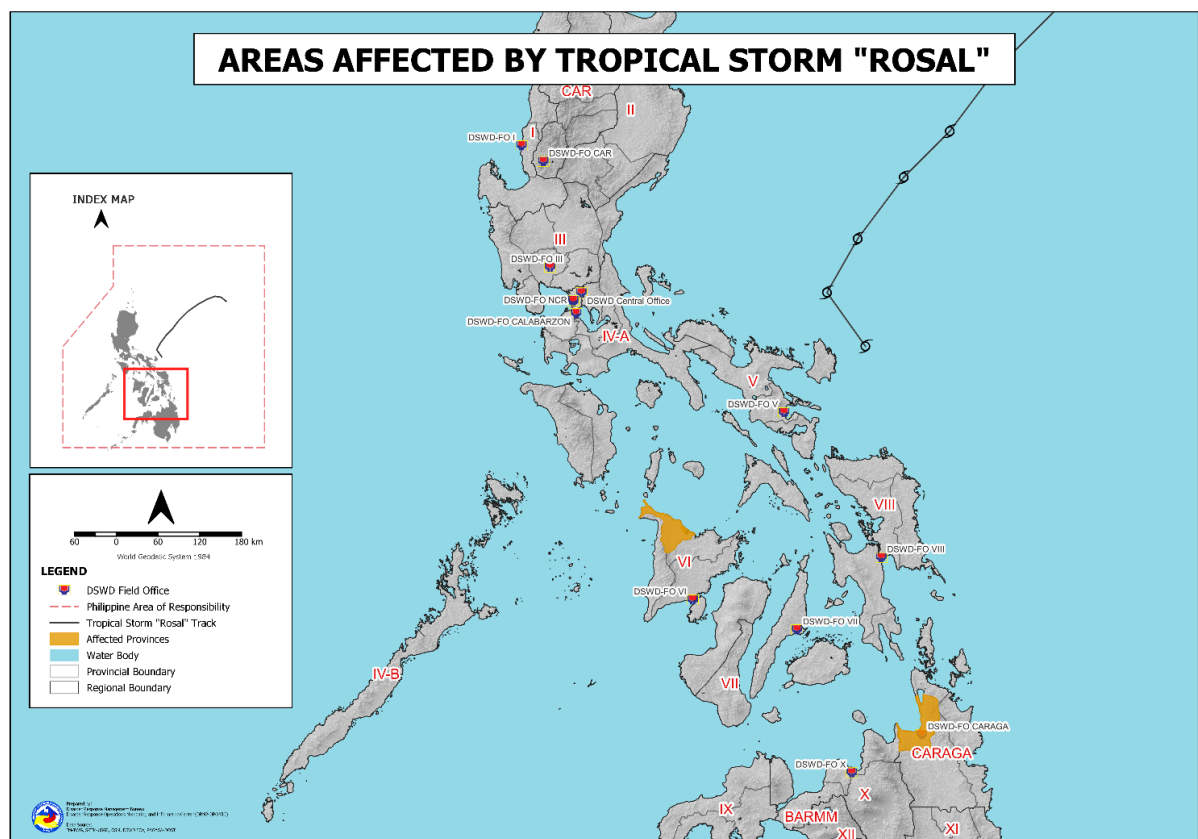
II. Status of Affected Areas and Population
