I. Situation Overview

On 09 December 2022 at around 2PM, an armed conflict transpired at Sitio Montawak, Brgy. Tapodoc, Aleosan, Cotabato involving members of the Civilian Armed Forces Geographical Unit (CAFGU) and other armed groups.

A total of **571 families** or **2,855 persons** were affected in **two (2) barangays** in **Aleosan, Cotabato** (see Table 1).
