

DSWD DROMIC Terminal Report on the Armed Conflict in Moises Padilla and Isabela, Negros Occidental

22 March 2023, 6PM

I. Situation Overview

On 28 November 2022 at around 5:30AM, an armed conflict transpired at the boundaries of Brgy. Quintin Remo, Moises Padilla and Brgy. Sebucuan, Isabela, Negros Occidental between the Government Troops and the members of the New People's Army.

A total of **112 families** or **468 persons** were affected in **two (2) barangays** in **Negros Occidental** (see Table 1).

A total of **112 families** or **468 persons** sought temporary shelter in **one (1) evacuation center** in **Negros Occidental** (see Table 2).
