I. Situation Overview

On 25 January 2023 at around 3:24 AM, a fire incident occurred in Brgy. 3, Sangandaan, Caloocan City. The fire was declared out at around 6AM.

2. Prepositioned FFPs and Other Relief Items

- 67,747 FFPs available in Disaster Response Centers; of which, 22,541 FFPs are at the National Resource Operations Center (NROC), Pasay City and 45,206 FFPs are at the Visayas Disaster Resource Center (VDRC), Mandaue City.
- 12,145 FFPs available at DSWD FO NCR.
- ₱334.14 million worth of other FNIs at NROC, VDRC, and DSWD FO NCR warehouses.
