

## DSWD DROMIC Report #1 on the Fire Incident in Brgy. 739, Manila City as of 25 January 2023, 6PM

### I. Situation Overview

On 24 January 2023 at around 4:03 PM, a fire incident occurred at F. Munoz St., Brgy. 739, Manila City. The fire was declared out at around 5:03 PM.

- 67,747 FFPs available in Disaster Response Centers; of which, 22,541 FFPs are at the National Resource Operations Center (NROC), Pasay City and 45,206 FFPs are at the Visayas Disaster Resource Center (VDRC), Mandaue City.
- 12,145 FFPs available at DSWD FO NCR.
- ₱334.14 million worth of other FNIs at NROC, VDRC, and DSWD FO NCR warehouses.
