I. Situation Overview

On 20 December 2022 at 1:32 PM, a fire incident occurred at Brgy. Compania Central, Molo Iloilo City. The fire was declared under control at 2:27 PM.

1. Standby Funds

2. Prepositioned FFPs and Other Relief Items

- 63,368 FFPs available in Disaster Response Centers; of which, 39,399 FFPs are at the National Resource Operations Center (NROC), Pasay City and 23,969 FFPs are at the Visayas Disaster Resource Center (VDRC), Mandaue City.
- 19,737 FFPs available at DSWD FO VI.
- ₱60.39 million worth of other FNIs at NROC, VDRC and DSWD FO VI warehouses.


c. Other Activities
