

DSWD DROMIC Report #1 on the Fire Incident in Brgy. Labangon, Cebu City as of 27 January 2023, 6PM

I. Situation Overview

On 25 January 2023 at around 11:43 AM, a fire incident occurred at Sitio Bon-Ami, Katipunan St., Brgy. Labangon, Cebu City. The fire was declared out at around 12:23 PM.

A total of **56 families** or **196 persons** are affected in **Brgy. Labangon, Cebu City** (see Table 1).
