I. Situation Overview

On 31 December 2023 at around 2:30 PM, a fire incident occurred in R-10 BGA Compound, Market 3, Brgy. NBBN, Navotas City. The fire was declared out 5:55 PM. Source: DSWD Field Office (FO) NCR

1. Standby Funds

- ₱24.52 million Quick Response Fund (QRF) at the DSWD Central Office.
- ₱5 million available at DSWD FO NCR.

2. Prepositioned FFPs and Other Relief Items

- 92,222 FFPs available in Disaster Response Centers; of which, 74,116 FFPs are at the National Resource Operations Center (NROC), Pasay City and 18,106 FFPs are at the Visayas Disaster Resource Center (VDRC), Mandaue City.
- 9,484 FFPs available at DSWD FO NCR.
- ₱269.2 million worth of other FNIs at NROC, VDRC, and DSWD FO NCR warehouses.
