

DSWD DROMIC Report #1 on the Fire Incident in Brgy. Patin-ay, Prosperidad, Agusan del Sur as of 19 December 2022, 6PM

I. Situation Overview

On 15 December 2022 at around 3PM, a fire incident occurred at Purok 3, Brgy. Patin-ay, Prosperidad, Agusan del Sur. It was declared fire out at around 5:06 PM. The cause of fire is still under investigation.
