On 24 January 2023 at around 3:20 PM, a fire incident occurred in Brgy. San Juan, Taytay, Rizal. The fire was declared out at around 4:42 PM.

1. Standby Funds

- ₱998.1 million Quick Response Fund (QRF) at the DSWD Central Office.
- ₱5 million available at DSWD FO CALABARZON.

2. Prepositioned FFPs and Other Relief Items

- 69,547 FFPs available in Disaster Response Centers; of which, 20,941 FFPs are at the National Resource Operations Center (NROC), Pasay City and 48,606 FFPs are at the Visayas Disaster Resource Center (VDRC), Mandaue City.
- 22,877 FFPs available at DSWD FO CALABARZON.
- ₱366.92 million worth of other FNIs at NROC, VDRC, and DSWD FO CALABARZON warehouses.
