as of 25 December 2022, 6PM

## I. Situation Overview

On 24 December 2022 at around 2:16 PM, a fire incident occurred at Zone 3 Juntado Subdivision, Brgy. Calumpang that also affected the boundary of Zone 5 Brgy. San Juan in Molo, Iloilo City. It was declared fire out at 3:07 PM. The cause of fire is still under investigation.
