

DSWD DROMIC Report #1 on the Landslide Incident in Davao Region as of 18 January 2023, 6PM

I. Situation Overview

On 14 January 2023 at around 4AM, the Municipalities of Maco and Monkayo in Davao de Oro experienced landslides due to heavy rains.

A total of **361 families** or **758 persons** are affected in **two (2) barangays** in **Davao de Oro** (see Table 1).

- ₱5 million available at DSWD FO XI.

2. Prepositioned FFPs and Other Relief Items

- 71,773 FFPs available in Disaster Response Centers; of which, 53,567 FFPs are at the National Resource Operations Center (NROC), Pasay City and 18,206 FFPs are at the Visayas Disaster Resource Center (VDRC), Mandaue City.
- 14,702 FFPs available at DSWD FO XI.
- ₱326.78 million worth of other FNIs at NROC, VDRC, and DSWD FO XI warehouses.


