

## DSWD DROMIC Report #16 on the Effects of Shear Line as of 10 January 2023, 6PM

### I. Situation Overview

On 26 December 2022, the Shear Line continuously affected Visayas and the northern portion of Mindanao while the Northeast Monsoon continuously affected Luzon.

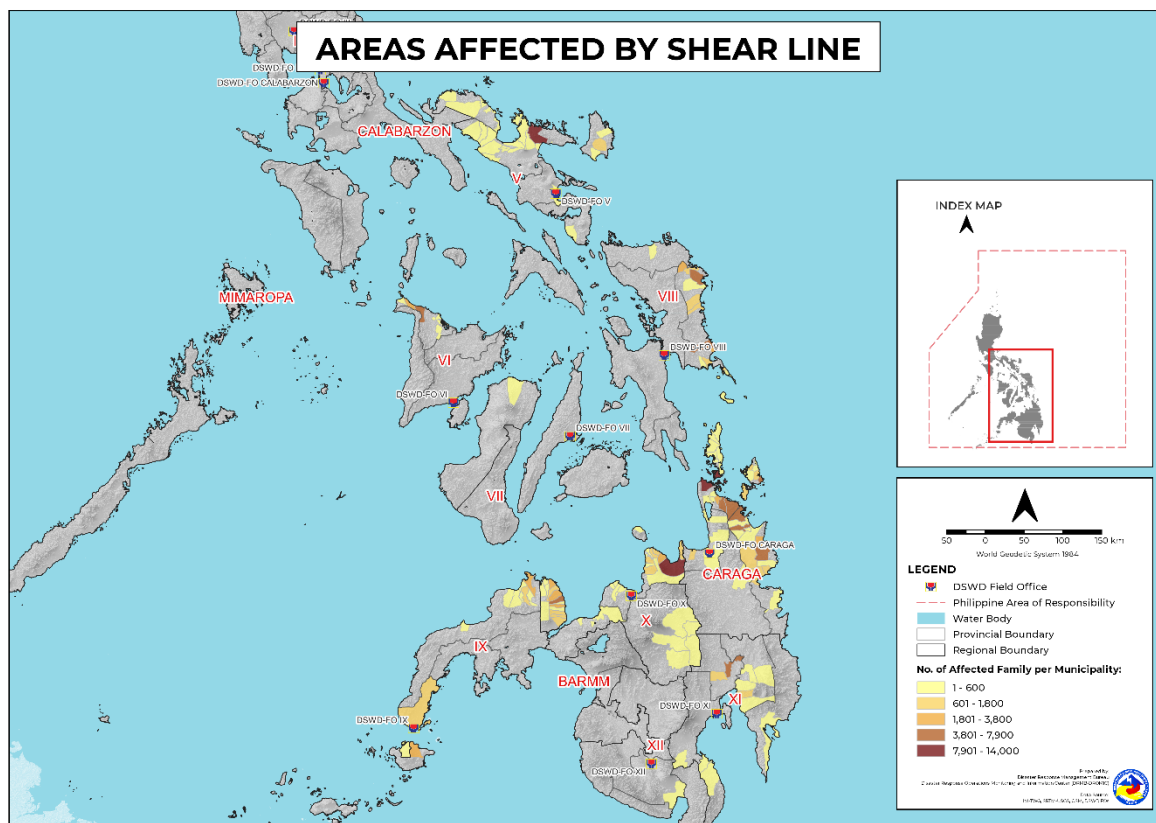
