

## DSWD DROMIC Report #2 on the Fire Incident in Brgy. Compania, Molo, Iloilo City

as of 24 December 2022, 6PM

### I. Situation Overview

On 20 December 2022 at 1:32 PM, a fire incident occurred in Brgy. Compania Central, Molo, Iloilo City. The fire was declared under control at 2:27 PM. Based on the initial assessment of the Bureau of Fire Protection (BFP), the cause of fire was allegedly due to faulty electrical wiring.

There are **16 families** or **27 persons** currently taking temporary shelter in **three (3) evacuation centers** in **Brgy. Compania, Molo, Iloilo City** (see Table 2).
