



DSWD DROMIC Report #2 on the Fire Incident in Brgy. Compania, Molo, Iloilo City

as of 24 December 2022, 6PM

I. Situation Overview

On 20 December 2022 at 1:32 PM, a fire incident occurred in Brgy. Compania Central, Molo, Iloilo City. The fire was declared under control at 2:27 PM. Based on the initial assessment of the Bureau of Fire Protection (BFP), the cause of fire was allegedly due to faulty electrical wiring.

a. Inside Evacuation Center

There are 16 families or 27 persons currently taking temporary shelter in three (3) evacuation centers in Brgy. Compania, Molo, Iloilo City (see Table 2).

1. Standby Funds

- ₱56.50 million Quick Response Fund (QRF) at the DSWD Central Office.
- ₱5 million available at DSWD FO VI.

2. Prepositioned FFPs and Other Relief Items

- 60,905 FFPs available in Disaster Response Centers; of which, 39,399 FFPs are at the National Resource Operations Center (NROC), Pasay City and 21,506 FFPs are at the Visayas Disaster Resource Center (VDRC), Mandaue City.
- 27,778 FFPs available at DSWD FO VI.
- ₱250.08 million worth of other FNIs at NROC, VDRC, and DSWD FO VI warehouses.

b. Food and Non-food Items (FNIs)

21 December 2022	 DSWD FO VI facilitated the distribution of FFPs, hygiene kits, sleeping kits, family kits, and kitchen kits to the families affected by the fire incident. The LGU of Iloilo City through its City Social Welfare and Development Office (CSWDO) distributed food packs, non-food items, and financial assistance to the families affected by the fire incident.

22 December 2022	• DSWD FO VI through the Assistance to Individuals in Crisis Situations (AICS) distributed financial assistance to the affected families amounting to a total of ₱195,000.00.
