

## DSWD DROMIC Report #2 on the Fire Incident in Brgy. Lapasan, Cagayan de Oro City, Misamis Oriental

### I. Situation Overview

On 19 December 2022 at around 1:18 PM, a fire incident occurred at Sitio Lawesbra, Brgy. Lapasan, Cagayan de Oro City, Misamis Oriental. The fire was declared under control at around 2:16 PM.
