

## DSWD DROMIC Report #2 on the Fire Incident in Brgy. NBBN, Navotas City as of 03 January 2023, 6PM

### I. Situation Overview

On 31 December 2023 at around 2:30 PM, a fire incident occurred at R-10 BGA Compound, Market 3, Brgy. NBBN, Navotas City. The fire was declared out at 5:55 PM.
