

## DSWD DROMIC Report #2 on the Fire Incident in Brgy. Veterans Village, Iloilo City

as of 28 December 2022, 6PM

### I. Situation Overview

On 26 December 2022 at around 5:39 AM, a fire incident occurred at Fort San Pedro, Brgy. Veterans Village, Iloilo City. The fire was declared out at around 6:11 AM.
