



# DSWD DROMIC Report #2 on the Flooding Incident in New Washington, Aklan

as of 27 December 2022, 6PM

### I. Situation Overview

On 23 December 2022 at around 10:30 PM, a flooding incident was experienced in several barangays in New Washington, Aklan. The flood eventually subsided at around 9AM on 24 December 2022.

# II. Status of Affected Areas and Population

A total of **473 families** or **2,254 persons** are affected in **five (5) barangays** in **New Washington**, **Aklan** (see Table 1).
