

## DSWD DROMIC Report #21 on the Effects of LPAs, Northeast Monsoon, and Shear Line as of 25 January 2023, 6PM

### I. Situation Overview

On 25 January 2023 at 4 PM, the Low Pressure Area (LPA) was estimated based on all available data at 380 km East Southeast of Davao City (5.2°N, 128.5°E). Northeast Monsoon affecting Luzon and Visayas.


