I. Situation Overview

On 26 December 2022, the Shear Line continuously affected Visayas and the northern portion of Mindanao while the Northeast Monsoon continuously affected Luzon.

A total of **₱10,772,830.50** worth of assistance was provided to the affected families; of which, **₱10,263,384.50** from **DSWD**, **₱288,591.00** from **Local Government Units (LGUs)**, and **₱220,855.00** from **other Partners** (see Table 6).
