

## DSWD DROMIC Report #4 on the Tornado Incidents in the Province of Iloilo

as of 19 January 2023, 6PM

### I. Situation Overview

On 03 January 2023 at around 5:30 AM, a tornado was experienced in several barangays in Arevalo, Iloilo City and Oton, Iloilo. On the same day, another tornado incident was experienced in the Municipality of Lambunao, Iloilo at around 11:00 PM.

A total of **271 families** or **1,319 persons** are affected in **five (5) barangays** in Iloilo (see Table 1).
