



DSWD DROMIC Report #4 on the Tornado Incidents in the Province of Iloilo

as of 19 January 2023, 6PM

I. Situation Overview

On 03 January 2023 at around 5:30 AM, a tornado was experienced in several barangays in Arevalo, Iloilo City and Oton, Iloilo. On the same day, another tornado incident was experienced in the Municipality of Lambunao, Iloilo at around 11:00 PM.

A total of **271 families** or **1,319 persons** are affected in **five (5) barangays** in **Iloilo** (see Table 1).

III. Status of Displaced Population

a. Outside Evacuation Center

There were a total of **34 families** or **152 persons** who temporarily stayed with their relatives or friends (see Table 2).

1. Standby Funds

- ₱23.75 million Quick Response Fund (QRF) at the DSWD Central Office.
- ₱5 million available at DSWD FO VI.

2. Prepositioned FFPs and Other Relief Items

- 73,673 FFPs available in Disaster Response Centers; of which, 55,467 FFPs are at the National Resource Operations Center (NROC), Pasay City and 18,206 FFPs are at the Visayas Disaster Resource Center (VDRC), Mandaue City.
- 33,157 FFPs available at DSWD FO VI.
- ₱323.78 million worth of other FNIs at NROC, VDRC and DSWD FO VI warehouses.
