



# DSWD DROMIC Terminal Report on the Effects of African Swine Fever in Region VI

06 April 2024, 6AM

# I. Situation Overview

With confirmed cases and reports on the spread of the African Swine Fever (ASF) in Western Visayas (Region VI), the effects of ASF have placed the Provinces of Aklan and Capiz as well as the Municipality of Hamtic in Antique under the State of Calamity (SoC) on 19 May 2023, 13 June 2023, and 22 June 2023, respectively.

ASF is a highly contagious viral disease of domestic and wild pigs, where the mortality rate can reach 100%. While ASF is not a danger to human health, it poses severe consequences to pig populations, particularly on the farming economy and livelihood of hog raisers in the affected locality.

In response, the DSWD through its Field Office in Region VI, provided relief augmentation to support the immediate needs of the affected hog raisers. Source: DSWD Field Office (FO) VI and World Organization for Animal Health (WOAH)

### II. Status of Affected Areas and Population

A total of **30,987 families** or **144,565 persons** were affected in **652 barangays** in **Region VI** (see Annex A).

### III. Cost of Humanitarian Assistance Provided

A total of **₱43,354,292.49** worth of assistance was provided by the **DSWD** to the affected families (see Annex B).
