



DSWD DROMIC Terminal Report on the Fire Incident in Brgy. Babag, Lapu-Lapu City, Cebu

19 February 2023, 6PM

I. Situation Overview

On 18 January 2023, around 3:30 PM, a fire broke out in Sitio Rada, Brgy. Babag, Lapu-Lapu City, Cebu and was declared fire out at 4:30 PM.

The incident has led to displacement of families and individuals wherein 26 houses were razed to the ground. Relative to the incident, the DSWD through its Field Office in Region VII promptly provided relief aid and financial assistance to support the immediate needs of the affected populace.

II. Status of Affected Areas and Population

A total of **33 families** or **114 persons** were affected in **Barangay Babag, Lapu-Lapu City, Cebu** in **Region VII** (see Annex A).

III. Status of Displaced Population

a. Inside Evacuation Center

A total of **26 families** or **79 persons** sought temporary shelter in **Brgy. Babag**, **Lapu-Lapu City, Cebu.** (see Annex B).

- b. Outside Evacuation Center
 A total of 7 families or 35 persons temporarily stayed with their relatives or friends (see Annex C).
- c. Total Displaced Population
 There are 33 families or 79 persons displaced in Brgy. Babag, Lapu-Lapu City,
 Cebu (see Annex D).

IV. Damaged Houses

A total of **26 houses** were **damaged**; of which **23** were **totally damaged** and **3** were **partially damaged** in **Brgy. Babag, Lapu-Lapu City, Cebu.** (see Annex E).

V. Cost of Humanitarian Assistance Provided

A total of ₱ 2,591,521.00 worth of assistance was provided to the affected families; composed of, ₱ 399,121.00 from DSWD, and ₱ 2,192,400.00 from Local Government Unit (LGU) (see Annex F).
