





# DSWD DROMIC Terminal Report on the Fire Incident in Brgy. Ibo, Lapu-Lapu City, Cebu

21 February 2024, 6AM

#### I. Situation Overview

On 16 January 2023 at around 10:51 AM, a fire incident occurred at Sitio Commonwealth, Brgy. Ibo, Lapu-Lapu City, Cebu. The fire was declared out at around 12:30 PM.

# II. Status of Affected Areas and Population

A total of **206 families** or **636 persons** were affected in **Brgy. Ibo, Lapu-Lapu City, Cebu** (see Annex A).

# III. Status of Displaced Population

## a. Inside Evacuation Center

A total of **167 families** or **487 persons** sought temporary shelter in **one (1) evacuation center** in **Brgy. Ibo, Lapu-Lapu City, Cebu** (see Annex B).

## b. Outside Evacuation Center

A total of **39 families** or **149 persons** temporarily stayed with their relatives or friends (see Annex C).

# c. Total Displaced Population

A total of **206 families** or **636 persons** were displaced in **Brgy. Ibo, Lapu-Lapu City, Cebu** (see Annex D).

# IV. Damaged Houses

A total of 110 houses were damaged; of which, 103 are totally damaged and seven (7) are partially damaged in Brgy. Ibo, Lapu-Lapu City, Cebu (see Annex E).

## V. Cost of Humanitarian Assistance Provided

A total of \$\mathbb{P}6,615,376.50\$ worth of assistance was provided to the affected families; of which, \$\mathbb{P}2,693,295.50\$ from DSWD, \$\mathbb{P}3,365,320.00\$ from the Local Government Unit (LGU), \$\mathbb{P}496,040.00\$ from Non-Government Organization (NGO) and \$\mathbb{P}60,721.00\$ from Red Cross, Philippine Air Force, Department of Public Works and Highways, and City Investigation and Detection Group (CIDG) (see Annex F).
