20 September 2023, 6PM

#### I. Situation Overview

On 23 December 2022, several municipalities in the Provinces of Oriental Mindoro and Palawan experienced flooding due to the effects of the Northeast Monsoon.

#### V. Cost of Humanitarian Assistance Provided

A total of \$\mathbb{P}3,376,514.60\$ worth of assistance was provided to the affected families; of which, \$\mathbb{P}3,172,090.60\$ from DSWD, \$\mathbb{P}185,979.00\$ from the Local Government Units (LGUs), and \$\mathbb{P}18,445.00\$ from the other Partners (see Table 6).
