

# DSWD DROMIC Terminal Report on the Mayon Volcanic Activity

## 28 January 2024, 6PM

### I. Situation Overview

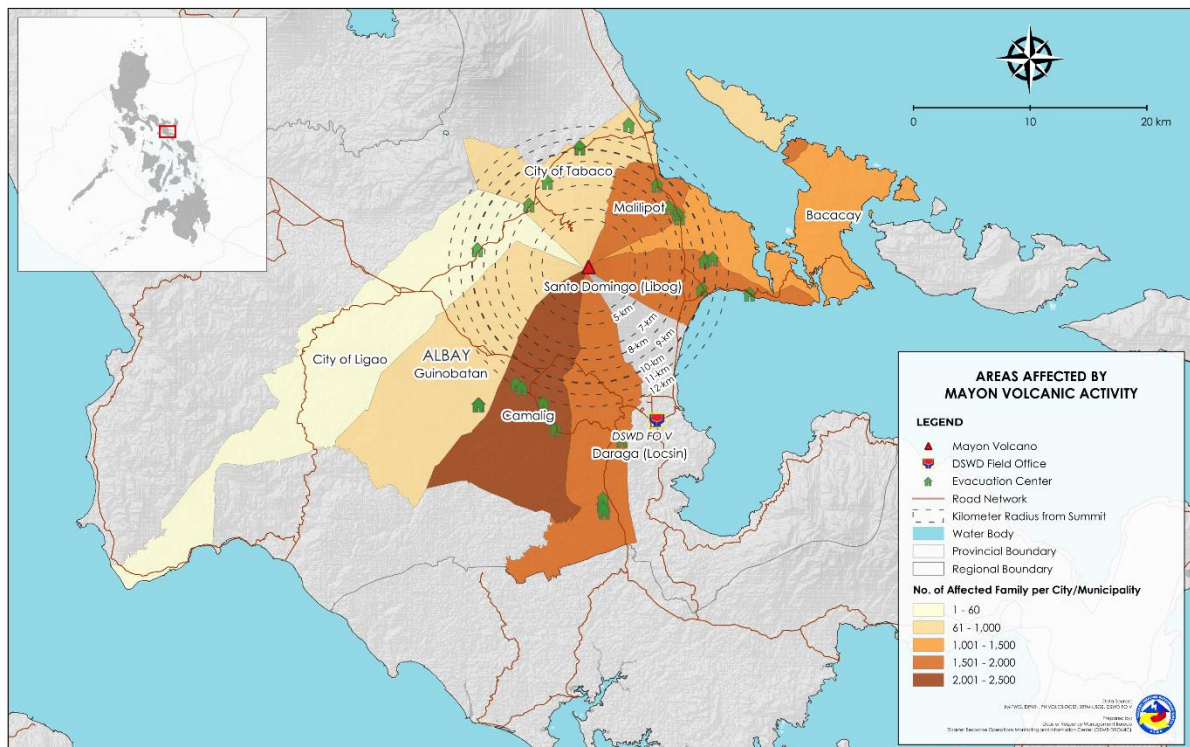
On 08 June 2023, the alert level for Mayon Volcano was raised from Alert Level 2 to Alert Level 3 which indicated an increased tendency towards a hazardous eruption that eventually resulted in the displacement of families and persons.

On 08 December 2023, the alert level of Mayon Volcano was lowered from Alert Level 3 (tendency towards a hazardous eruption) to Alert Level 2 (moderate level of unrest) and displaced families and persons have also returned to their respective places of origin.

### II. Status of Affected Areas and Population

A total of **9,873 families** or **38,382 persons** were affected in **26 barangays** in **Albay** (see Annex A).



### III. Status of Displaced Population

#### a. Inside Evacuation Center

A total of **5,474 families** or **19,153 persons** sought temporary shelter in **29 evacuation centers** in **Albay** (see Annex B).

**b. Outside Evacuation Center**

A total of **418 families** or **1,454 persons** temporarily stayed with their relatives or friends (see Annex D).

**c. Total Displaced Population**

A total of **5,892 families** or **20,607 persons** were displaced in **Albay** (see Annex E).

#### **IV. Cost of Humanitarian Assistance Provided**

A total of **₱326,827,480.55** worth of assistance was provided by **DSWD** to the affected families, of which, **₱164,180,190.55** are **food and non-food items (FNIs)**, **₱28,090,000.00** are **financial assistance** through **Assistance to Individuals in Crisis Situation (AICS)**, and **₱134,557,290.00** through **Emergency Cash Transfer (ECT)** (see Table 1).
