

## DSWD DROMIC Report #1 on the Armed Conflict in Baggao, Cagayan

as of 04 February 2023, 6PM

### I. Situation Overview

On 02 February 2023, the troops of the 95<sup>th</sup> Infantry Battalion under the Operational Control of 501<sup>st</sup> Infantry Brigade conducted an intensified military operation to eradicate insurgents in Cagayan which resulted to a firefight against a local communist terrorist group within the vicinity of Brgy. Hacienda Intal, Baggao, Cagayan.
