

## DSWD DROMIC Report #1 on the Fire Incident in Brgy. Addition Hills, Mandaluyong City as of 13 February 2023, 6PM

### I. Situation Overview

On 12 February 2023 at around 6:30 AM, a fire incident occurred in Brgy. Addition Hills, Mandaluyong City. The fire was declared out at around 9:41 AM.
