I. Situation Overview

On 04 February 2023 at around 2:30 AM, a fire incident occurred at Brgy. Basak. Lapu-Lapu City. The fire was declared out at around 4:30 AM.

1. Standby Funds

- ₱758.09 million Quick Response Fund (QRF) at the DSWD Central Office.

2. Prepositioned FFPs and Other Relief Items

- 120,067 FFPs available in Disaster Response Centers; of which, 35,561 FFPs are at the National Resource Operations Center (NROC), Pasay City and 84,506 FFPs are at the Visayas Disaster Resource Center (VDRC), Mandaue City.
- 32,022 FFPs available at DSWD FO VII.
- ₱378.78 million worth of other FNIs at NROC, VDRC, and DSWD FO VII warehouses.

c. Other Activities

04 February 2023	 The City Social Welfare and Development Office (CSWDO) of the LGU of Lapu-Lapu City conducted intake interviews and profiling of the affected families. DSWD FO VII closely coordinated with the CSWDO of the LGU of Lapu-Lapu City for the assessment of affected families, provision of technical assistance on camp coordination and camp management (CCCM), and internally displaced person (IDP) protection, and any request of relief augmentation.
