I. Situation Overview

On 04 February 2023 at around 2:30 AM, a fire incident occurred at Brgy. Basak, Lapu-Lapu City. The fire was declared out at around 4:30 AM.

04 February 2023	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> The City Social Welfare and Development Office (CSWDO) of the LGU of Lapu-Lapu City conducted intake interviews and profiling of the affected families. DSWD FO VII closely coordinated with the CSWDO of the LGU of Lapu-Lapu City for the assessment of affected families, provision of technical assistance on camp coordination and camp management (CCCM), and internally displaced person (IDP) protection, and any request of relief augmentation.
