- ₱352.32 million worth of other FNIs at NROC, VDRC, and DSWD FO VI warehouses.

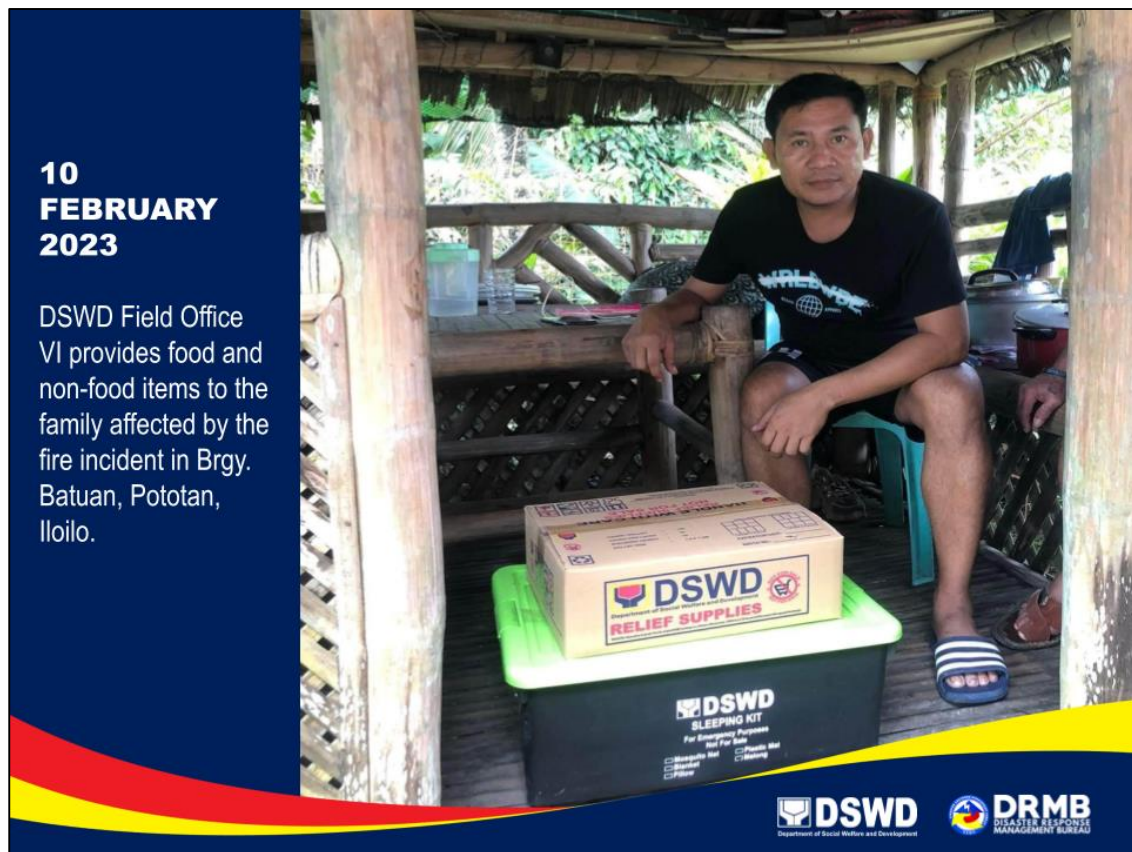
